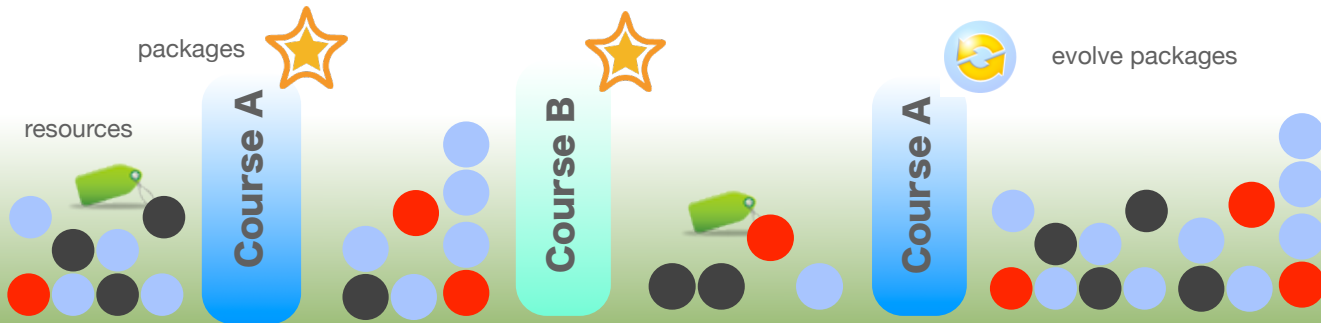


Social Collation and Annotation of Learning Resources



Course creators add resources over time and bring them together into an annotated package. Packages can then be exported for VLE loading or use.

(1) Add websites, documents, references (2) Tag, collate, annotate, publish (3) Export (4) Repeat

Using social bookmarking and other Web 2.0 platforms, course creators can build rich sets of course resources in the flow of their day to day work. More advanced systems allow packaging and export, ready for VLE loading or use.

Tips on Getting Started



Use collaborative and time saving features for multiple course creators to capture and build resource packages. i.e. Bookmarklets



Tag and organise resources to create searchable indexes of resources. If supported, enable search by type of resource.



Allow students to subscribe to new items and updates by course or topic to support ongoing informal learning.
